	To determine your level of creativity, we ask for you to send us a concise portfolio, in print of digitally. The portfolio has to consist of your own work and/or work of others, in support of your inspiration, motivation and goals. It can be work related to shoes, but does not necessarily have to be.					
	 The portfolio has the following requirements: Full-colour (if relevant, therefore for pictures and possibly coloured drawings) One-sided A4 format Minimum 4 to maximum 10 pages After the selection process, we will return the portfolios; therefore make sure to mention your name of every page. 					
	Portfolios that do not meet these requirements will not be considered.					
Step 3						
Activity Result	The teachers of the Industrial Footwear Design course will preform a pre-selection. You will either continue to step 4 or not. You will be notified in writing.					
Step 4						
Activity Resultt	You will complete an assignment and have an interview with teachers of IFD. We will know your talent, motivation and perseverance.
